NAFEX PORTAL

434. SHRI HARISH CHANDRA MEENA:

Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE AND FARMERS WELFARE कृषि और किसान कल्याण मंत्री be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of farmers registered on the NAFEX.in portal from Rajasthan, particularly from Tonk and Sawai Madhopur districts;
- (b) whether training and registration camps have been organized in Tonk and Sawai Madhopur districts to increase the participation of farmers;
- (c) the steps taken to provide small farmers with access to the digital auction system without intermediaries; and
- (d) whether usage data received from Rajasthan is being monitored to assess the impact of the portal on the income of farmers and if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

(a) to (d): NAFEX.in is a digital e-auction portal developed by National Agricultural Cooperative Marketing Federation of India Limited (NAFED) to facilitate transparent, fair and technology-driven e-auction of stocks procured under the Price Support Scheme (PSS) and the Price Stabilization Fund (PSF) across the country by NAFED. The portal is exclusively meant for e-auction of procured stocks and does not provide for farmer registration or procurement / auction from farmer. Accordingly, no farmer registration is carried out on the portal, including in Tonk and Sawai Madhopur districts of Rajasthan. Farmers can sell their agricultural produce through National Agriculture Market (e-NAM), a pan-India electronic trading platform set up to facilitate transparent and competitive online trading of agricultural commodities. Since its inception in April 2016 till 30th June, 2026, nine (9) mandis across the Tonk and Sawai Madhopur districts of Rajasthan have been integrated with the e-NAM platform. A total of 2.08 lakh farmers from these districts have been registered on the e-NAM platform. As on 30 June 2026, these e-NAM integrated mandis have recorded a cumulative trade volume of 18,50,981 MT and a cumulative trade value of ₹ 8839.71 crore on the e-NAM platform.
