Periodic Labour Force Survey (PLFS):

- During last five financial years, the following reports on the Periodic Labour Force Survey have been published and can be accessed through in the website of MoSPI:
 1. Five Annual Reports from 2020-21 to 2023-24 and 2025 have been published. 2020-21 refers to the survey period of July, 2020 to June, 2021 and accordingly for other years. 2025 refers to the survey period of January-December, 2025.
 2. **Nineteen Quarterly Bulletins** covering the period April-June 2021 to October-December 2024 were published.
 3. To generate high-frequency labour force indicators, the publication of Monthly Bulletins of PLFS was initiated from April, 2025. Thereafter, 12 Monthly Bulletins for the period April 2025 to March 2026 were published.
