Will the Minister of CIVIL AVIATION be pleased to state :-

- (a) whether the Ministry is upgrading 35 non-metro airports at an estimated investment of Rs. 12,434 crore and is looking at various ways to raise money;
- (b) if so, the details worked out so far and the implementation status in each State particularly in the tier II and tier III cities; and
- (c) the funds earmarked and spent so far?

(a), (b) & (c) Airports Authority of India (AAI) had allocated a sum of Rs. 4505 crores towards the development of 35 non-metro airports. This expenditure would primarily be met through internal resources of AAI and partly by way of borrowings. The details and status of the development works undertaken at these non-metro airports and the amount earmarked and expenditure incurred till September, 2010 are at Annexure.
