Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state :-

- (a) the allotment of 107 New Kendriya Vidyalayas and the academic year in which it is proposed to start these institutions, State-wise; and
- (b) whether State Governments are consulted for location of these institutions in their States?

ANSWER

- (a) Government has accorded approval for opening of 107 new Kendriya Vidyalayas during the remaining period of the Eleventh Five Year Plan. 89 Kendriya Vidyalayas have already been opened during the current academic session. The State-wise break-up is annexed.
- (b) Kendriya Vidyalayas under civil or defence sector are opened based on feasible proposals received from State Governments or Ministries or Departments of the Government of India. For opening of Vidyalayas, the sponsoring agencies which include State Governments are required to provide the required land free of cost and are also required to provide temporary accommodation for the first few years.
