2. The Department related Parliamentary Standing Committee on Education, Women, Children, Youth and Sports, has been examining the subject in light of Article 15(5) contained in Part III of the Indian Constitution and the current Report is on Implementation of Article 15(5) of Indian Constitution regarding Special Provision for Reservation to SCs/STs and OBCs in Educational Institutions including Private Educational Institutions. The Committee wishes to place on record its gratitude to the representatives of the Departments of Higher Education, Ministry of Education, Secretary, University Grants Commission, Vice-Chancellors and representatives from Birla Institute of Technology and Science, Pilani, OP Jindal Global University, Sonipat, Ashoka University, Sonipat, Shiv Nadar University, Greater Noida, Azim Premji University, Bengaluru and Manipal Academy of Higher Education (MAHE), Manipal for making submissions, furnishing necessary information/documents and rendering valuable assistance to the Committee in its deliberations.

3. For the facility of reference and convenience, the recommendations of the Committee have been presented in bold letters at the end of the Report.

4. The Committee considered the draft Report and adopted the same in its meeting held on the 18<sup>th</sup> August, 2025.

## REPORT

1.1 The affirmative action by the Governments in a welfare State, particularly through reservation, is an intervention designed to address historical and ongoing socio-economic backwardness and discrimination experienced by certain groups in society, to promote socio-economic equality by providing increased opportunities and representation and thereby ensuring human and overall national development. Article 15(5) of the Indian Constitution, enacted through the 93rd Amendment in 2005, empowers the State to make special provisions for socially and educationally backward classes, Scheduled Castes (SCs), and Scheduled Tribes (STs) in admissions to educational institutions, including private ones, except minority institutions. This provision is a significant step toward addressing historical inequalities and promoting inclusive education by enabling affirmative action policies, such as reservations, to ensure equitable access to opportunities for marginalized communities. The rationale for its implementation lies in addressing deep-rooted social inequalities perpetuated by historical disadvantages faced by these communities. By enabling affirmative action through reservations, Article 15(5) seeks to ensure equitable access to education, a critical tool for socio-economic mobility, thereby fostering inclusivity and reducing disparities in opportunities. This provision aligns with the Constitutional commitment to social justice, aiming to level the playing field for groups marginalized by caste and socio-economic factors, thus promoting their integration into mainstream educational and professional spheres.

1.2 The implementation of Article 15(5) is further justified by the need to correct systemic barriers that have historically limited access to quality education for SCs, STs, and OBCs. It recognizes that merit cannot be judged solely on academic performance without accounting for structural inequalities like lack of access to resources, quality schooling, or socio-economic support. By mandating reservations in Central and Private educational institutions, as seen in the Central Educational Institutions (Reservation in Admission) Act, 2006, the provision ensures that these communities can access higher education and compete in an increasingly competitive job market. Despite challenges like debates over merit and institutional capacity, the rationale remains rooted in creating a more equitable society where education serves as a catalyst for empowerment and social transformation.

1.3 In view of the above, the Committee heard the views of Department of Higher Education, Ministry of Education, Vice-Chancellors of Ashoka University, Sonapat, O.P. Jindal Global University, Sonapat, Shiv Nadar University, Greater Noida and Birla Institute of Technology and Science (BITS), Pilani etc. on 5<sup>th</sup> August, 2025. The Committee also heard the representatives of Azim Premji University, Bengaluru and Manipal Academy of Higher Education (MAHE), Manipal, Karnataka during its Study Visit to Bengaluru, Karnataka on 27<sup>th</sup> December, 2024 on the subject.

## **2. Views of the Department of Higher Education, Ministry of Education on Implementation of Article 15 (5) of the Constitution:-**

2.1 During the meeting of the Committee on 5<sup>th</sup> August, 2025, the Secretary, Department of Hogher Education informed that the Constitution (Ninety-third Amendment) Act, 2005, adjoined a sub-clause 5 to Article 15, which states “ *Nothing in this article or in sub-clause (g) of clause (1) of article 19 shall prevent the State from making any special provision, by law, for the advancement of any socially and educationally backward classes of citizen or for the Scheduled Castes or the Scheduled Tribes in so far as such special provision relate to their admission to educational institutions including private educational institutions, whether aided or unaided by the State, other than the minority educational institutions referred to in clause (1) of article 30.*”

2.2 Accordingly, the Parliament enacted The Central Educational Institutions (Reservation in Admission) Act, 2006 (notified on 4th January, 2007) and the Central Educational Institutions (Reservation in Admission) Amendment Act, 2012 (notified on 20th June 2012), to provide for reservation in admission of the students belonging to the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes and the Other Backward Classes of citizens, to certain Central Educational Institutions established, maintained or aided by the Central Government, and for matters connected therewith or incidental thereto.

2.3 The Parliament also enacted the Central Educational Institutions (Reservation in Teachers' Cadre) Act, 2019 to provide for reservation of posts in appointments by direct recruitment of persons belonging to the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes and the Other Backward Classes and the economically weaker sections, to teachers' cadre in certain Central Educational Institutions established, maintained or aided by the Central Government, and for matters connected therewith or incidental thereto. “Central Educational Institutions”, as defined in these two Acts, means:-

- (i) a university established or incorporated by or under a Central Act;
- (ii) an institution of national importance set up by an Act of Parliament;
- (iii) an institution, declared as a deemed University under section 3 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956 (3 of 1956), and maintained by or receiving aid from the Central Government;
- (iv) an institution maintained by or receiving aid from the Central Government, whether directly or indirectly, and affiliated to an institution referred to in

clause (i) or clause (ii), or a constituent unit of an institution referred to in clause (iii);

- (v) an educational institution set up by the Central Government under the Societies Registration Act, 1860(21 of 1860);

2.4 Department has also informed that as per the above definition, Reservation Policy stipulated by the Government of India is followed only in Universities/Institutions given as under:-

- (i) Central Universities (CUs)
- (ii) Indian Institutes of Technology (IITs),
- (iii) Indian Institutes of Information Technology (IIITs),
- (iv) Indian Institutes of Management (IIMs),
- (v) National Institutes of Technology (NITs),
- (vi) Indian Institute of Engineering Science and Technology (IIST) Shibpur,
- (vii) Indian Institutes of Science Education and Research (IISERs), and
- (viii) All Centrally Funded Institutes (CFIs).

2.5 As informed by the Department, the Private Universities, which are established by the Act of State Legislatures, are not qualified as Central Educational Institutions. Reservation Policy stipulated by above mentioned Acts is not applicable in following Universities/Institutions:-

- (i) Universities established by the State Government (Reservation as per State Government Act shall be applicable here);
- (ii) University whether aided or unaided by the State Government (Reservation as per State Government Act shall be applicable here);
- (iii) Institution deemed to be University declared by the Central Government under Section 3 but not receiving grants-in-aid (fully or partially) from the Central Government, whether directly or indirectly;
- (iv) Minority Educational Institutions (under Article 30 (1) of Indian constitution)

2.6 Department has further informed the Committee that Ashoka University was established under the Haryana Private Universities Act, 2006 vide notification no. Leg. 24/2014 dated May 2, 2014. As Education is in the concurrent list of Indian Constitution, it is also the responsibility of the State Government to make suitable legislative provisions for providing reservation in the Higher Educational Institutes established by them. Private Universities are also established by the Act of State Legislature. Institutions of Eminence deemed to be Universities (Birla Institute

of Technology & Science Pilani; O. P. Jindal Global University and Shiv Nadar University) do not receive grants from the Central Government. In view of this above, the Central Government has not made any statutory provisions for implementing Article 15 (5) of the Indian Constitution.

2.7 In response to a question asked by the Committee regarding Social Composition of students in higher education, the Department has informed that the Department of Higher Education conducts the All India Survey of Higher Education (AISHE) to collect data on student enrolment, faculty, etc. from each recognised Higher Education Institution (HEI) including the Private Universities/Institutions in India. Latest published data is available for the academic year 2022-23. Data is provided on voluntary basis by all Higher Education Institutions. Information on social category wise number of students as provided by the private HEIs show that representation of Scheduled Caste and OBC students more or less conform to the prescribed norms. As per the latest available AISHE data for 2022-23 (provisional), the category wise Enrolment data for government and private higher education institutions is as follows:

2.8 In response to another question asked by the Committee regarding consideration of social composition of students in NIRF framework, the Department of Higher Education has informed that the National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF) includes social-caste composition as a key element under its "Outreach and Inclusivity" parameter, which carries 100 marks and contributes 10% to the institution's overall ranking score. Under this parameter, a sub-parameter which carries 20 marks, evaluates how many students from socially and economically disadvantaged backgrounds receive full tuition fee reimbursement from Institutional funds, Central/State Government schemes and Private sponsorships. If 50% students of the total student intake receive such reimbursement, the institution earns full 20 marks in this sub-parameter.

2.9 Further, while replying to a question asked by the Committee regarding use of social-caste composition in National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC), the Department has informed that the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) takes into account the social-caste composition of the institution in its accreditation framework. In the existing Revised Accreditation Framework (RAF), NAAC includes the following components:

- i. Percentage of seats filled against reserved categories (SC, ST, OBC, etc.) as per applicable reservation policy for the first year admission year-wise during the last five years;
- ii. Number of actual students admitted against the reserved categories in the first year of the programme year-wise during the last five years; and
- iii. Total number of seats earmarked for reserved category as per GOI or State Government rule and number of seats filled against reserved category year-wise during the last five years.

2.10 Apart from this, the University/HEI is also required to upload the specific document as per description given below:

- i. Institutional data in the prescribed format (data template);
- ii. The relevant information in institutional website as part of public disclosure;
- iii. Copy of the letter issued by the State Government or Central Government indicating the reserved categories (SC, ST, OBC, Divyangjan, etc.) to be considered as per the State rule (Translated copy in English to be provided as applicable); and
- iv. Final admission list indicating the category as published by the HEI and endorsed by the competent authority.

2.11 In response to a question asked by the Committee, the Department of Higher Education has informed that there are 517 private universities in the country as per list given at Annexure-I. There are around 56 Central Universities and 504 State Universities in the public sector in the country as on date as per the data available at UGC website as per list given at Annexure-II.

### **3. Views of the Private Universities/HEIs**

#### **3.1 BIRLA INSTITUTE OF TECHNOLOGY AND SCIENCE (BITS)- PILANI, RAJASTHAN**

The representatives of Birla Institute of Technology and Science (BITS), Pilani, informed the Committee that it was established in 1964 and rooted in a legacy extending back to 1946, is a

premier private deemed university known for excellence in engineering, science, and technology. The Institute operates through its five residential campuses at Pilani (Rajasthan), Goa, Hyderabad, Mumbai and an international offshore campus in Dubai, UAE. BITS Pilani was designated as an Institution of Eminence (IoE) by the Ministry of Education, Government of India, in 2020, making it one of the first six Institutes to receive this status. The IoE framework confers enhanced autonomy in academic, administrative, and financial matters, enabling global innovation, curriculum flexibility, and international collaboration. The Institute has also emerged as a vibrant hub for entrepreneurship, with 16 BITSian founded Unicorns highlighting its impact on the startup ecosystem.

BITS-Pilani, Rajasthan has been notified as ‘Institution of Eminence’ by the Ministry of Education under the World Class Institutions scheme. Being private educational institutions, they are governed by the UGC (Institutions of Eminence Deemed to be Universities) Regulations, 2017 (as amended). The regulatory framework confers enhanced autonomy in academic, administrative, and financial matters, enabling global innovation, curriculum flexibility, and international collaboration.

3.1.1 Fee Structure of BITS, Pilani is given as under:-

3.1.2 In response to a question asked by the Committee, whether BITS, Pilani follows any policy of reservations for the SC, ST, and/or OBC communities in admission of the students and appointment of teaching staffs, it was informed that the BITS Pilani does not follow any reservation policy in student admissions or faculty recruitment. As per Clause 15.0 of the UGC (Institutions of Eminence, Deemed to be Universities) Regulations, 2017, the applicability of reservation policies pertains specifically to public IoEs and does not extend to private unaided institutions such as BITS Pilani. In accordance with the autonomy granted under the Institutions of Eminence (IoE) framework, admissions and faculty appointments at BITS Pilani are conducted strictly based on academic credentials, through transparent, competitive, and identity-neutral selection processes.

3.1.3 In response to a question asked by the Committee regarding current composition of students in BITS, Pilani category-wise, it was informed that BITS Pilani does not mandatorily collect caste-based demographic data at the time of student admissions. The institute's admission process is entirely based on academic performance, and no caste, community, or category identifiers are solicited or considered at any stage of selection. Based on voluntarily self-declared data by students, the category-wise composition of admitted students over the past four academic years is presented below:-

Additionally, BITS Pilani enrolls a growing number of international students, particularly at its Dubai campus, and through specialized academic pathways such as joint research programs, semester exchange, and 2+2 dual degree agreements with reputed foreign universities. These initiatives foster a multicultural academic environment and further enrich the institute's learning and research ecosystem.

3.1.4 In reply to another question asked by the Committee regarding key advantages secured by BITS, Pilani upon being declared as Institutions of Eminence, the Committee was informed that the designation of BITS Pilani as an Institution of Eminence (IoE) by the Ministry of Education, Government of India, has enabled the institute to access a wide range of academic, administrative, and strategic advantages aimed at enhancing global competitiveness and institutional excellence. The key benefits include:

- (i) Academic and Operational Autonomy: Full freedom to design and revise curriculum, admission policies, fee structures, and faculty recruitment processes, enabling responsiveness to global academic standards and innovation;
- (ii) International Expansion: Flexibility to establish offshore campuses, pursue global research collaborations, and enter into academic agreements with internationally ranked institutions;
- (iii) Institution-Specific Inclusion Policies: Autonomy to design and implement financial aid, scholarships, and inclusive education mechanisms aligned with the institute's values and social impact goals;

- (iv) **Global Faculty Engagement:** The institute actively recruits faculty from international institutions, including long-term and visiting appointments from countries such as the United States, Germany, Australia, and the UK, enhancing academic diversity and global exposure;
- (v) **International Student Community:** BITS Pilani hosts international students, especially at its Dubai campus, and continues to expand participation through exchange programs, research internships, and dual degree pathways;
- (vi) **Collaborations with Foreign Universities;**
- (vii) **2+2 Dual Degree Programs:** Students spend two years at BITS Pilani and two years at a partnering foreign university, earning degrees from both institutions;
- (viii) **Joint Ph.D. and Research Programs:** Doctoral scholars benefit from co-supervised research conducted across BITS and international partner institutions; and
- (ix) **Global Research Partnerships:** Through the BITS Global Research Alliance, the institute facilitates joint research, faculty exchange, and innovation-driven projects with top universities worldwide.

These advantages enable BITS Pilani to align closely with the core objectives of the IoE mandate, internationalization, excellence in research and teaching, and institutional self-governance, positioning it as a globally relevant, socially conscious academic leader.

### **3.2 O.P. JINDAL GLOBAL UNIVERSITY (JGU), SONIPAT**

3.2.1 The institution was established in the year 2009 and has evolved into a multi-disciplinary and research oriented university. Its twelve schools focus on Law, Business & Management, International Affairs, Public Policy, Liberal Arts & Humanities, Journalism, Art & Architecture, Banking & Finance, Environment & Sustainability, Psychology & Counselling, Languages & Literature and Public Health & Human Development. It was notified as an Institution of Eminence vide Ministry's notification dated 04.11.2020. JGU recognizes that DEI (Diversity, Equality and Inclusion) is an ongoing effort and will continuously assess and improve this policy. The university will seek feedback from the campus community and consult with experts in DEI to ensure best practices are implemented and sustained over time.

3.2.2 O.P. Jindal Global University, Sonipat, Haryana has been notified as 'Institution of Eminence' by the Ministry of Education under the World Class Institutions scheme. Being private educational institutions, they are governed by the UGC (Institutions of Eminence Deemed to be Universities) Regulations, 2017 (as amended). The regulatory framework confers enhanced autonomy in academic, administrative, and financial matters, enabling global innovation, curriculum flexibility, and international collaboration.

3.2.3 As informed by the O.P. JINDAL GLOBAL UNIVERSITY, SONIPAT the Fee Structure is as under:-

**3.2.4** In response to a question asked by the Committee, whether OP Jindal Global University, Sonipat follows any policy of reservations for the SC, ST, and/or OBC communities in admission of the students and appointment of teaching staffs, it was informed that the institute upholds the values of diversity, inclusion, and equal opportunity in both admissions and recruitment. Efforts are made to ensure fair representation of individuals from all social and educational backgrounds, including those from SC, ST, and OBC communities. O.P. Jindal Global University (JGU) maintains the constitutional principles of equality, inclusion, and non-discrimination in admissions of students as well as recruitment of faculty members. While we do not implement caste-based reservations, we provide generous financial support through merit scholarships, need-based aid, and special fellowships to help students achieve their academic goals. All recruitment and admission decisions are strictly on the basis of merit and institutional requirements, with no prejudice based on caste, religion, gender, colour, or nationality. In order to avoid any possible bias, JGU does not require caste or religious information in its recruitment exercise.

**3.2.5** In response to another question asked by the Committee regarding the reasons for non-implementation of reservation in admission, it was informed that the UGC (Institutions of

Eminence Deemed to be Universities) regulations, 2017, there are specific provisions for reservation in admissions of students in the public institutions only.

3.2.6 In response to a question asked by the Committee regarding current composition of students in OP Jindal Global University, Sonipat, category-wise, the details was furnished in tabular form as given under:-

3.2.7 In reply to another question asked by the Committee regarding key challenges faced by institution in securing students from SC, ST, and OBC categories, the Committee was informed that students from SC, ST, and OBC communities often encounter barriers such as limited access to information about higher education, financial constraints, and disparities in School-level academic support. Factors like geographic location, digital access, and social circumstances can also influence their ability to explore and pursue opportunities in institutions of higher learning. O.P. Jindal Global University (JGU) recognizes that students from Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, and Other Backward Castes may face structural and social barriers that affect their access to higher education opportunities. There are also notable disparities in academic preparation, especially due to gaps in School-level support and guidance. Additional factors such as geographic remoteness, unequal digital access, and broader social and cultural circumstances further restrict students' ability to explore and pursue opportunities in institutions of higher learning. Therefore, number of applications from aspiring students from the Scheduled Caste, Scheduled Tribes, and Other Backward Castes are low as compared to the applications received from the general category. Even lesser number of students meet merit requirements. However, JGU ensures equal opportunities and access to all students based on equality, inclusion and non-discrimination.

3.2.8 In reply to another question asked by the Committee regarding key advantages secured by OP Jindal Global University, Sonipat upon being declared as Institutions of Eminence, the Committee was informed that O.P. Jindal Global University (JGU) reflects the aspirations of the country for access to high-quality, globally benchmarked education within the country. Established with the vision of offering an academically rigorous and internationally relevant alternative to studying abroad, JGU is founded on a model of multidisciplinary and liberal education that aligns with global best practices while being rooted in national priorities. The recognition of JGU as an IoE, has relatively eased the environment for the university to enable us

to focus on our core tasks as a not-for-profit university, pluralistic in academic orientation and celebrating diversity of all kinds with a commitment to academic freedom and socially relevant education. The status of IoE has also enabled us to gain credibility as a serious institution of higher education learning. As per the Ministry of Education, Government of India's Notification regarding the conferment of IoE status on JGU, we are now exempt from all UGC Regulations and other guidelines in relation to Admission and Fee Structure; Flexibility in Course Structure; Recruitment of Faculty; Academic Collaborations; Financial Autonomy and Inspection vide Clause 11.0 and Clause 11.1 to 11.6 of UGC (Institutions of Eminence Deemed to be Universities) Regulations, 2017. The IoE status has provided the University with more academic, administrative, and financial independence and the ability to: Design and implement innovative and flexible curricula; Recruit faculty through an independent and merit-based process; Forge collaborative partnerships with top-ranked global universities; Initiate interdisciplinary programmes responding to modern challenges; High-impact research in international standardsProvide socially global education.

3.2.9. In reply to another question asked by the Committee regarding the challenges that are being faced/anticipated in implementation of Article 15(5) of the Indian Constitution, it was informed that achieving the vision of educational equity as outlined in Article 15(5) requires addressing structural and contextual differences in access to resources and academic preparation. Institutions should also work to ensure that inclusion efforts are aligned with overall academic quality and institutional goals.

3.2.10 In reply to another question asked by the Committee regarding the steps taken/proposed to be taken by JGU to overcome the challenges in implementation of Article 15(5) of the Indian Constitution, the Committee was informed that JGU continues to be committed towards creating an inclusive and diverse academic environment in accordance with the Constitution of India and international best practices in higher education. JGU continues to make significant efforts to go beyond the provisions of Article 15(5). The University continues to be committed to nurturing a diverse, inclusive, and socially responsive academic community, commensurate with the values as incorporated in the Constitution of India and global best practices in higher education.

### **3.3 SHIV NADAR UNIVERSITY, GREATER NOIDA**

3.3.1 The representatives of Shiv Nadar University informed the Committee that Shiv Nadar University, located in Delhi-NCR, was established on 4 April 2011. On 3 August 2022, the Ministry of Education, Government of India, notified it as an Institution of Eminence (IoE) Deemed to be University under the UGC (Institutions of Eminence Deemed to be Universities) Regulations, 2017. It is a comprehensive, multi-disciplinary, and research-focused university. It offers over 50 academic programs across four Schools:

- i. School of Engineering
- ii. School of Natural Sciences
- iii. School of Humanities & Social Sciences
- iv. School of Management and Entrepreneurship

3.3.2 Additionally, the Academy of Continuing Education supports lifelong learning and professional upskilling. The University is committed to academic excellence and research innovation. It emphasises not only the dissemination of knowledge but also its creation through basic and applied research, scholarly output, and creative expression.

3.3.3 Shiv Nadar University, Greater Noida has been notified as ‘Institution of Eminence’ by the Ministry of Education under the World Class Institutions scheme. Being private educational institutions, they are governed by the UGC (Institutions of Eminence Deemed to be Universities) Regulations, 2017 (as amended). The regulatory framework confers enhanced autonomy in academic, administrative, and financial matters, enabling global innovation, curriculum flexibility, and international collaboration.

3.3.4 In response to a question asked by the Committee, whether Shiv Nadar University follows any policy of reservations for the SC, ST, and/or OBC communities in admission of the students and appointment of teaching staffs, it was informed that Clause 15 of the IoE Regulatory Framework restricts reservation obligations only to public Institutions of Eminence, stating they must implement the reservation “in accordance with any Act of Parliament for the time being in force”. As per the UGC IOE Regulations 2017, clause no. 11.1.1 stipulates that ‘domestic students shall have to be selected through a transparent merit-based system...’ Private IoEs, like Shiv Nadar Institution of Eminence, are not mandated by these Regulations to follow reservations in admissions or appointments.

3.3.5 In response to another question asked by the Committee regarding current composition of students in Shiv Nadar University category-wise, it was informed that the composition of students is as under:-

EWS:9, General: 2736, OBC: 537, SC:48, ST: 29, Total: 3359

3.3.6 In response to another question asked by the Committee regarding the institute’s current composition of faculty by SC, ST, OBC, and General categories, the Committee was informed that though the Institute is not mandated to disclose the social status, faculty can voluntarily provide the status which is then captured in the central database and it is given as under.

General: 70, OBC:19, SC:1, Not Available: 200, Total: 290

3.3.9 In reply to another question asked by the Committee regarding key advantages secured by the University upon being declared as Institutions of Eminence, the Committee was informed that being designated a private Institution of Eminence under the UGC (Institutions of Eminence – Deemed to be Universities) Regulations, 2017, has added to our stature as an institution. The Gazette notification of the Ministry of Education dated 3 August 2022 under clause no 10 (i) also grants us, significant regulatory autonomy, notably under Clauses 11.1 to 11.6 of the IoE Regulations 2017 to help us advance the NEP 2020, However, as a private institution we do not receive any direct financial support from the Government of India as the public institutions do. All other regulatory requirements, such as UGC, AICTE (for relevant programs), DEB, statutory

compliance, and UGC guidelines including fee refund obligations, continue to apply to us in the same manner as before.

### **3.4 ASHOKA UNIVERSITY**

3.4.1 The representatives of the Ashoka University informed the Committee that it is a pioneer in its focus on providing a liberal (multidisciplinary) education since 2014. Its aim is to help students become well-rounded individuals who can think critically about issues from multiple perspectives, communicate effectively and become leaders with a commitment to public service. An Ashoka education carries a strong emphasis on foundational knowledge, thorough academic research based on rigorous pedagogy, and hands-on experience with real-world challenges. The 3276 students, drawn from 21 countries, 28 states, and 287 towns and cities, receive a world-class interdisciplinary education through undergraduate and post-graduate programmes led by internationally renowned faculty. 45% of students on campus are on Financial Aid, 5000+ students benefitted from aid over 11 years, INR 610 Crores committed towards Aid since inception. The University has 195 regular faculty, and around 60-70 visiting faculty

3.4.2 In response to a question by the Committee regarding policy of reservations for SC, ST, and / or OBC communities in admission of students and appointment of teaching staffs, the University informed the Committee that in student admissions, Ashoka University has been following a merit-based admission policy as mandated by Section 35 of the Haryana Private Universities Act. As per clause 35 (3): "A minimum of 25% seats for admissions in the university shall be reserved for students of the State of Haryana, out of which 10% seats shall be reserved for students belonging to Scheduled Castes of the State of Haryana". Merit based admission policies has been applied for all applicants both for Haryana students and general category students. Admissions process in Ashoka University is highly transparent, objective and intended to select best students on the basis of merit and means irrespective of their social and economic status as mandated by the Act. It was further informed that, in teaching, there is no reservation policy.

3.4.3 In response to another question asked by the Committee regarding current composition of students in Ashoka University, category-wise, it was informed that University is not collecting the details regarding category. Total number of students as on date are 3276, number of students Programme-wise given as under:-

Undergraduate Programmes (B.A. (Hons) / B.Sc (Hons)): 2772

Postgraduate Programmes (M.A. (Hons) / M.Sc (Hons)): 137

Postgraduate Diploma Programme (YIF): 144

Ph.D Programmes: 223

3.4.4 In reply to another question asked by the Committee regarding the challenges that are being faced/anticipated in implementation of Article 15(5) of the Indian Constitution, it was informed that the University is actively exploring ways to promote diverse student body.

3.4.5 In reply to another question asked by the Committee regarding the steps taken/proposed to be taken by Ashoka University to overcome the challenges in implementation of Article 15(5) of the Indian Constitution, the Committee was informed that University is making every effort to admit Haryana students. The seats are going vacant due to a lower applicant pool from Haryana

and the fact that all students who were made offers have not joined. Even after lowering the merit criteria for Haryana students, all seats are not getting filled.

3.4.6 In reply to another question asked by the Committee regarding the steps taken / proposed to be taken by Ashoka University to overcome the challenges in implementation of article 15(5) of the Indian Constitution, the Committee was informed that over the years the University has been doing active outreach to Haryana schools and the number of Haryana students getting an offer from the University is going up every year.

### **3.5 Azim Premji University**

The representatives of Azim Premji University informed the Committee that University was established in 2010 by Azim Premji Foundation as a State Private University in Bengaluru, Karnataka. The explicit social purpose of the University is to prepare competent and socially committed graduates capable of contributing to the country. The University is philanthropic in nature and offers extensive financial support to students. It was further informed that the University has 3800+ alumni, with majority working in the social sector across India, Azim Premji University, Bhopal, began operations in 2023, Third University at Ranchi has received approval from the State Government.

#### **3.5.1 Approach for Inclusion of Students with Socio-Economic Disadvantaged backgrounds**

- (i) Admissions
- (ii) Financial Assistance
- (iii) Academic Support
- (iv) Support for Students with Disabilities
- (v) Personal well-being (available to all students)

#### **3.5.2 Admissions**

- (i) Preferential treatment to students from socio-economically disadvantaged backgrounds
- (ii) Each student is assigned a Socio-Economic Disadvantage (SED) index
  - a) Based on gender, caste, religion, father's education, mother's education, household occupation, household annual income, region, and state
  - b) Statistically robust method based on Indian Human Development Survey data regarding the likelihood of students from each group entering higher education
  - c) SED index-based score is added to the entrance test scores to calculate an SED adjusted admissions score for each student

- d) Modified ranked list which boosts the scores of students from disadvantaged backgrounds. Offers for admissions are based on this modified admissions list.

3.5.3 Financial Assistance- Wide range of financial assistance is provided for students.

Financial support to students includes:

- (i) Need-based full or partial waivers for tuition and accommodation fees;
- (ii) Need-based support for food and fieldwork expenses;
- (iii) Campus project assistantships; and
- (iv) Free medical insurance for all students - medical coverage for outpatient and hospitalization expenses.

3.5.4 Academic Support

- (i) Before admission
  - a. 'Bridge' programmes conducted at multiple locations, and online
  - b. Help students from disadvantaged backgrounds prepare for admission tests for higher educational institutions (including ours)
- (ii) After admission
  - a. Summer and winter programmes to help with academic preparation before the start of the academic semester and in between semesters
  - b. Ongoing support on language, quantitative skills and work-readiness through a dedicated Academic Resource Centre

3.5.5 Support for Students with Disabilities- Multiple types of support is provided which includes- Physical infrastructure to enable barrier-free movement, Academic accommodations and additional institutional and peer support mechanisms, and Specialized support and assistive technologies for teaching and learning (e.g. for students with visual impairments). Personal Well-being Support is available to all students.

3.5.6 Article 15(5) of the Indian Constitution empowers the State to make special provisions for socially and educationally backward classes, Scheduled Castes (SCs), and Scheduled Tribes (STs) in admissions to educational institutions, including private ones, except minority institutions. The composition of students, category-wise is given as under:-

### 3.6 Manipal Academy of Higher Education (MAHE)

3.6.1 The representative of Manipal Academy of Higher Education (MAHE) informed the Committee that declared as a “Deemed to be University” on 1st June 1993; UGC has approved a Memorandum of Association (MoA), which is the guiding document (rules and regulations) for MAHE. In October 2020, MAHE has been conferred the status of an “Institution of Eminence Deemed to be University” by the Ministry of Education, Government of India.

3.6.2 The relevant clause with respect to Reservations i.e. Clause 6.1 of the MoA (Rules & Regulations) approved by UGC while declaring MAHE as a Deemed to be University in 1993, is reproduced below:

***“The academy shall be open to persons of either sex and of whatever race, creed, caste or class and no test of condition shall be imposed as to religious belief or profession in admitting or appointing members, students, teachers, workers or in any other connection whatsoever.”***

As per the Clause 15.0 of the UGC (Institutions of Eminence Deemed to be Universities) Regulations, 2017 ***“The Public Institutions of Eminence shall implement the reservation policy in admissions and recruitment in accordance with any Act of Parliament for the time being in force.”*** Thus, MAHE being a self-financing private Institution of Eminence Deemed to be University, the reservation policy is not applicable.

3.6.3 Since 1993, MAHE adopted the policy of not having any reservation, either for the students or for the faculty/staff, based on caste, creed, gender, religion, physical fitness/disability etc. MAHE has been recruiting staff on pan India basis and from abroad, without any reservation for any category. Hence, MAHE has not collected the data related to caste, creed, gender, religion, etc of the staff recruited. However, the MAHE has provided category-wise details of its employees as under (as on 28.12.2024):-

**3.7 The Committee notes that in the case of Ashok Kumar Thakur vs. Union of India (2008) the validity of the 93rd Constitutional Amendment, which introduced reservations for Other Backward Classes (OBCs) in educational institutions, was examined. The Supreme Court upheld the Constitutional validity of the Amendment and the Central Educational Institutions (Reservation in Admission) Act, 2006, which provided for 27% reservation for OBCs in central educational institutions. The court also emphasized the need to exclude the "creamy layer" within the OBCs from these benefits to ensure that benefits reach the most disadvantaged sections of OBCs and balanced the need for social justice through reservations with the principle of merit. By upholding this reservation, the Supreme Court of India reinforced the State's power to implement affirmative action for Socially and Educationally Backward Classes (SEBCs). Further, in IMA v Union of India, the Supreme Court on May 12, 2011, upheld Article 15 (5) for private unaided non-minority educational institutions. Finally, in Pramati Educational and Cultural Trust v Union of India, on Jan 29, 2014, the Supreme Court for the first time explicitly upheld the entirety of Article 15(5) of the Indian Constitution. It is clear therefore that reservations for Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, and Socially and Educationally Backward Classes of citizens in private educational institutions is constitutionally permissible.**

**3.8 The Committee notes that as per the All-India Survey of Higher Education (AISHE) 2021-22, there were 685 Government managed Universities/University-level institutions (i.e., 240 Central Government institutions and 445 State Government institutions) and 473 private un-aided Universities. Since then, the number of private universities has only grown, with the UGC currently counting 517 private universities in the country. Among degree colleges, according to the AISHE Report 2021-22, only 21.5% of India's 45,473 colleges are government institutions, 13.2% are private aided institutions, and 65.3% are private unaided institutions. The Committee observes that in view of these numbers, as well as the country's growing population and number of students and the NEP's targets for 50% GER in higher educational institutions, it is clear that the public sector educational**

institutions will be unable to accommodate all students and that private HEIs shall play a vital role in accommodating students from each category of society.

**3.9** The Committee reaffirms its observation from its 364<sup>th</sup> Report on the Demand for Grants of the Higher Education Department 2025-26, where it noted that “there is an increasing trend of higher education in India being seen in two separate spheres—one is that of private and select Government institutions with better faculty and resources, and the other are the majority of the HEIs which are not able to keep pace with the former.” The provision of reservation for SCs, STs, and OBCs in public higher educational institutions (HEIs) and the absence of such provision in the private HEIs may result in students from these communities disproportionately taking admission in public institutions that are not able to keep pace. The Committee strongly emphasizes that education must be a key instrument of attaining social justice in this country, and notes that the current absence of reservations in private HEIs may be an impediment to the same.

**3.10** The Committee notes that the fees per annum as provided by private universities are substantial and that students from marginalized sections of society may not be able to afford these fees. The Committee, therefore, feels that it is imperative for the State to take affirmative steps through legislation to accommodate students from these categories and to fully implement Article 15(5) of the Indian Constitution.

**3.11** The Committee notes that Article 15(5) of the Indian Constitution explicitly empowers the State, as defined in Article 12 of the Indian Constitution, to include private aided and unaided institutions of higher education in the scheme of reservations for SCs, STs, and SEBCs. However, private educational institutions are currently not legally obliged to implement reservation policies since there is no statute mandating them to do so. The Committee, therefore, recommends that Article 15(5) of the Indian Constitution be implemented in full across the country through legislation by Parliament. *The Committee recommends that 27%, 15% and 7.5% seats should be reserved for OBCs, SCs, and STs respectively in private higher educational institutions.*

**3.12** The Committee however notes that in the interest of fairness, any introduction of reservations for SCs, STs, and OBCs in private HEIs must be fully covered financially by the Government. The Committee notes that the introduction of 25% quota in private schools under Section 12(1)C of the Right to Education Act is fully reimbursable by the Government – this is the model which the Government must follow in private HEIs as well.

**3.13** The Committee observes that as per the data furnished by Department of Higher Education, Private HEIs have representations of 40% OBC, 14.9% SC and 5% ST students

out of total students studying in Private Universities/HEIs. However, as per the data furnished by Private Universities/HEIs mentioned above, the numbers of OBC students admitted therein are considerably low while the numbers of SC and ST students in above mentioned Universities are abysmally low. In BITS, during the year 2024-25, out of total students of 5,137, OBCs are about 514, SCs are 29 and STs are 4, which is around 10 percent in case of OBC, 0.5 per cent in case of SCs and just about 0.08 per cent in case of STs, though some students have not declared their category. Similarly, in O.P. Jindal Global University, out of total 3,181 students, 28 are SCs, 29 are STs which is less than 1 percent. Moreover, in case of Shiv Nadar University, out of a grand total of 3,359, SCs are 48 and STs are 29 which is 1.5 per cent and approximately 0.5 per cent, respectively. The Committee therefore, recommends the Department of Higher Education to implement reservation quotas in educational institutions, including private ones, proportional to the population of SCs, STs and Other Backward Classes (OBCs). Also, the Department should ensure its compliance through a central oversight/monitoring body like UGC, National Commission for Backward Classes and SC/ST Commissions to monitoring implementation of Article 15(5) of Indian Constitution, ensuring these institutions report admission data annually.

3.14 The Committee also observes that expanding reservation will require increasing seats. However, many private institutions lack infrastructure like classrooms, hostels, faculty, etc., to accommodate additional students from SC, ST and OBC communities without compromising quality and reduction in General category seats. The Committee, therefore, recommends that Central and State Government should allocate dedicated funds for private Educational Institutions/HEIs to increase seats, build infrastructure, and hire faculty in institutions implementing reservations. The Central and State Government should also supplement resources through Public Private Partnerships (PPP) in education. The Department of Higher Education through Higher Education Funding Agency (HEFA) should provide low-interest loans to HEIs/ Universities for infrastructure expansion, ensuring no reduction in General category seats to avoid reducing General category opportunities.

**3.15** The Committee observes that students from marginalized sections of the society often face challenges competing in entrance exams or coping with rigorous curricula due to poor foundational education in rural or underfunded schools. High drop-out rate among reserved category students in premier institutions highlight this gap. The Committee notes that certain universities like Ashoka University and Azim Premji University have already implemented orientation and bridge programs to support students from underrepresented backgrounds. Ashoka University's Academic Bridge Program (ABP) consists of a three-week bridge course and year-long support during the student's first year. The Committee recommends that the Department study such models and develop certain model programs (bridge courses, free coaching for entrance exams, etc.) that private HEIs can adopt to support effective implementation of Article 15(5). Similarly, the Department may also provide scholarships which can bear the burden of living costs in hostels to students taking admission through quotas in private HEIs.

**3.16** The Committee notes that caste based discrimination in premier institutions have been reported very often. Students admitted under reservation quota, particularly SC/ST backgrounds also face stigma and discrimination from peers and faculty in premier HEIs which negatively impacts their performance and their mental health. The Committee, therefore, strongly recommends enforce strict anti-discrimination policies/laws in institutions with grievance redressal cells to address caste-based issues. Also, sensitization programs for faculty and students in this regard should be conducted regularly.

**3.17** The Committee further observes that many students from marginalized sections especially in rural and remote areas are unaware of reservation benefits or they lack access to application processes due to digital divides and bureaucratic hurdles. The Committee notes that certain universities, like Ashoka University in Sonapat, have implemented partnerships with Jawaharlal Navodaya Vidyalayas and other organisations to support admissions for students from underrepresented backgrounds. The Committee recommends the Department to collaborate with NGOs and community leaders to reach remote areas, ensuring students know about available opportunities and application processes. The Committee also recommends that the Department undertake an awareness campaign

among these communities to ensure wider dissemination of the opportunities available to them in private HEIs following any law that the Parliament may pass for the same.

**3.18** The Committee also recommends the Department to enforce the creamy layer principle for OBCs while implementing Article 15(5) of the Indian Constitution, to ensure that benefits reach the most disadvantaged OBCs. Further, income and eligibility criteria should be updated regularly.

**3.19** The Committee observes that Article 46 of Indian Constitution directs the State to promote educational and economic interests of Scheduled Castes (SCs), Scheduled Tribes (STs), and other weaker sections of society and Article 15(5) serves as a tool to achieve this constitutional mandate. The Committee, therefore, recommends that implementation of Article 15(5) should be aligned with Directive Principles of State Policy contained in Article 46 to promote holistic upliftment SEBCs, SCs, STs and EWS categories. The Committee also recommends the Department to take effective steps to provide reservation benefits to EWS category from General castes in private educational institutions to ensure holistic development of each section of the society.

**3.20** The Committee also recommends that the Department take steps to improve the quality of data currently collected on the composition of the student population in private and public HEIs. Currently, the most updated and reliable data source is the AISHE Report of 2021-2022, i.e., three years ago. Further, as the Committee noted in its 364<sup>th</sup> Report on the Demand for Grants of the Higher Education Department 2025-26, some of the data in the AISHE report is unreliable— for instance, it claims that Anna University has only 1 faculty member. The Committee reaffirms that AISHE must be conducted yearly and that there needs to be quality checks to improve the accuracy of the data.

**3.21** The Committee also recommends that HEIs, including private unaided HEIs, mandatorily collect data on the caste category of all applicants as well as admitted students. It is important for HEIs and the Department to understand the social composition of the student body as well as the prospective pool of applicants. The current system of making caste declaration optional may result in a caste-blindness of the admissions process. Applicants and students may however be given the choice to declare that they do not have a caste identity.

**3.22** The Committee appreciates the efforts undertaken by private HEIs to financially support their students, an effort which has resulted in the intake of students from economically weaker sections. For instance, the Committee was pleased to note that 49% of

**students at Ashoka University are on some form of financial aid, which undoubtedly contributes to an inclusive and diverse student body. Similarly, the Committee appreciated the Vidyagyan scholarship at Shiv Nadar University which supports students from school education through university. The Committee also noted that scholarships support diversity in social groups as well – for instance, at Shiv Nadar University, the Masters in Rural Management program is nearly fully funded by scholarships, resulting in a class composition which is more diverse (38.8% ST, 25% OBC, and 16% SC). The Committee also appreciates Azim Premji University’s Socio-Economic Disadvantage (SED) index, which enables the University to consider each applicant’s individual social and economic circumstances in deciding on an application.**

## **OBSERVATIONS/RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE COMMITTEE AT A GLANCE**

1. The Committee notes that in the case of **Ashok Kumar Thakur vs. Union of India (2008)** the validity of the 93rd Constitutional Amendment, which introduced reservations for **Other Backward Classes (OBCs)** in educational institutions, was examined. The Supreme Court upheld the Constitutional validity of the Amendment and the **Central Educational Institutions (Reservation in Admission) Act, 2006**, which provided for 27% reservation for OBCs in central educational institutions. The court also emphasized the need to exclude the "creamy layer" within the OBCs from these benefits to ensure that benefits reach the most disadvantaged sections of OBCs and balanced the need for social justice through reservations with the principle of merit. By upholding this reservation, the Supreme Court of India reinforced the State's power to implement affirmative action for **Socially and Educationally Backward Classes (SEBCs)**. Further, in **IMA v Union of India**, the Supreme Court on May 12, 2011, upheld Article 15 (5) for private unaided non-minority educational institutions. Finally, in **Pramati Educational and Cultural Trust v Union of India**, on Jan 29, 2014, the Supreme Court for the first time explicitly upheld the entirety of Article 15(5) of the Indian Constitution. It is clear therefore that reservations for Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, and Socially and Educationally Backward Classes of citizens in private educational institutions is constitutionally permissible. (Para 3.7)

2. The Committee notes that as per the **All-India Survey of Higher Education (AISHE) 2021-22**, there were 685 Government managed Universities/University-level institutions (i.e., 240 Central Government institutions and 445 State Government institutions) and 473 private un-aided Universities. Since then, the number of private universities has only grown, with the UGC currently counting 517 private universities in the country. Among degree colleges, according to the AISHE Report 2021-22, only 21.5% of India's 45,473 colleges are government institutions, 13.2% are private aided institutions, and 65.3% are private unaided institutions. The Committee observes that in view of these numbers, as well as the country's growing population and number of students and the NEP's targets for 50% GER in higher educational institutions, it is clear that the public sector educational institutions will be unable to accommodate all students and that private HEIs shall play a vital role in accommodating students from each category of society.

3. The Committee reaffirms its observation from its 364<sup>th</sup> Report on the Demand for Grants of the Higher Education Department 2025-26, where it noted that “there is an increasing trend of higher education in India being seen in two separate spheres—one is that of private and select Government institutions with better faculty and resources, and the other are the majority of the HEIs which are not able to keep pace with the former.” The provision of reservation for SCs, STs, and OBCs in public higher educational institutions (HEIs) and the absence of such provision in the private HEIs may result in students from these communities disproportionately taking admission in public institutions that are not able to keep pace. The Committee strongly emphasizes that education must be a key instrument of attaining social justice in this country, and notes that the current absence of reservations in private HEIs may be an impediment to the same.

(Para 3.9)

4 The Committee notes that the fees per annum as provided by private universities are substantial and that students from marginalized sections of society may not be able to afford these fees. The Committee, therefore, feels that it is imperative for the State to take affirmative steps through legislation to accommodate students from these categories and to fully implement Article 15(5) of the Indian Constitution.

(Para 3.10)

5. The Committee notes that Article 15(5) of the Indian Constitution explicitly empowers the State, as defined in Article 12 of the Indian Constitution, to include private aided and unaided institutions of higher education in the scheme of reservations for SCs, STs, and SEBCs. However, private educational institutions are currently not legally obliged to implement reservation policies since there is no statute mandating them to do so. The Committee, therefore, recommends that Article 15(5) of the Indian Constitution be implemented in full across the country through legislation by Parliament. *The Committee recommends that 27%, 15% and 7.5% seats should be reserved for OBCs, SCs, and STs respectively in private higher educational institutions.*

(Para 3.11)

6. The Committee however notes that in the interest of fairness, any introduction of reservations for SCs, STs, and OBCs in private HEIs must be fully covered financially by the Government. The Committee notes that the introduction of 25% quota in private schools under Section 12(1)C of the Right to Education Act is fully reimbursable by the schools from the Government – this is the model which the Government must follow in private HEIs as well.

7. The Committee observes that as per the data furnished by Department of Higher Education, Private HEIs have representations of 40% OBC, 14.9% SC and 5% ST students out of total students studying in Private Universities/HEIs. However, as per the data furnished by Private Universities/HEIs mentioned above, the numbers of OBC students admitted therein are considerably low while the numbers of SC and ST students in above mentioned Universities are abysmally low. In BITS, during the year 2024-25, out of total students of 5,137, OBCs are about 514, SCs are 29 and STs are 4, which is around 10 percent in case of OBC, 0.5 per cent in case of SCs and just about 0.08 per cent in case of STs, though some students have not declared their category. Similarly, in O.P. Jindal Global University, out of total 3,181 students, 28 are SCs, 29 are STs which is less than 1 percent. Moreover, in case of Shiv Nadar University, out of a grand total of 3,359, SCs are 48 and STs are 29 which is 1.5 per cent and approximately 0.5 per cent, respectively. The Committee therefore, recommends the Department of Higher Education to implement reservation quotas in educational institutions, including private ones, proportional to the population of SCs, STs and Other Backward Classes (OBCs). Also, the Department should ensure its compliance through a central oversight/monitoring body like UGC, National Commission for Backward Classes and SC/ST Commissions to monitoring implementation of Article 15(5) of Indian Constitution, ensuring these institutions report admission data annually.

8. The Committee also observes that expanding reservation will require increasing seats. However, many private institutions lack infrastructure like classrooms, hostels, faculty, etc., to accommodate additional students from SC, ST and OBC communities without compromising quality and reduction in General category seats. The Committee, therefore, recommends that Central and State Government should allocate dedicated funds for private Educational Institutions/HEIs to increase seats, build infrastructure, and hire faculty in institutions implementing reservations. The Central and State Government should also supplement resources through Public Private Partnerships (PPP) in education. The Department of Higher Education through Higher Education Funding Agency (HEFA)

should provide low-interest loans to HEIs/ Universities for infrastructure expansion, ensuring no reduction in General category seats to avoid reducing General category opportunities.
